We're like those friends who always have a good time riding their horses. We tell awesome stories about our horses and the cool things other equestrians have learned, focusing on living the equestrian life.

In 2023, I was honoured to represent Canada in the Global Amateur Tour in France, where I competed with a young stallion and earned first place in my class. This experience was life-changing, and I'm thrilled to have been selected again for the 2025 tour, this time in Portugal.
